**Subject:** Pix Transmissions Limited - Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) on Dividend

Dear Shareholder,

We are pleased to inform you that the Board of Directors of the Company, at its Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 have recommended a final dividend of Rs 6/- (60%) per Equity Share of Rs. 10/- each for the financial year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023. This dividend will be paid, subject to approval of the Shareholders of the Company at the ensuing Annual General meeting (AGM) scheduled on Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2023.

Pursuant to the changes introduced by the Finance Act, 2020, w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2020, the Company would be required to withhold taxes at the prescribed rates on the Dividend paid to its Shareholders. The withholding tax rate would vary depending on the residential status of the Shareholder and the documents submitted by them and accepted by the Company. Accordingly, the above referred final dividend will be paid to the Shareholders after deducting the tax at source as follows:

### 1. Resident Shareholders:

Recording of the valid Permanent Account Number (PAN) for the registered Folio/DP id-Client Id is mandatory. In absence of valid PAN, tax will be deducted at a higher rate of 20% as per Section 206AA of the Act. In case the shareholder with PAN is identified as specified person under Section 206AB, higher rate of TDS as applicable shall be deducted.

Shareholders holding shares under multiple accounts under different status / category and single PAN, may note that, higher of the tax as applicable to the status in which shares held under a PAN will be considered on their entire holding in different accounts.

The Company is not obligated to apply the beneficial Tax Treaty rates at the time of tax deduction/withholding on dividend amounts. Application of beneficial Tax Treaty Rate shall depend upon the completeness of the documents submitted by the Non- Resident Shareholder and review to the satisfaction of the Company.

Kindly note that the aforementioned documents are required to be submitted to our Registrars & Transfer Agents, Link Intime India Private Limited at its dedicated link mentioned below- <https://web.linkintime.co.in/formsreg/submission-of-form-15g-15h.html> on or

before 11th July, 2023, 5.00 p.m. Indian Standard Time (IST) in order to enable the Company to determine and deduct appropriate TDS/ withholding tax rate. No communication on the tax determination/deduction shall be entertained post 11th July, 2023, 5:00 p.m. (IST). It may be further noted that in case the tax on said dividend is deducted at a higher rate in absence of receipt of the aforementioned details/documents from you, there would still be an option available with you to file the return of income and claim an appropriate refund, if eligible. No claim shall lie against the Company for such taxes deducted.

In the event of any income-tax demand (including interest, penalty, etc.) arising from any misrepresentation, inaccuracy or omission of information provided / to be provided by the shareholders, such shareholders will be responsible to pay and indemnify such income-tax demand (including interest, penalty, etc.) and provide the Company with all information / documents that may be necessary and co-operate in any proceedings before any income-tax/apellate authority.

The Company will arrange to e-mail a soft copy of the TDS certificate at the Shareholder's registered email ID, post payment of the said Dividend if approved by the Shareholders at the ensuing AGM. Shareholders will also be able to see the credit of TDS in Form 26AS, wherever PAN is available which can be downloaded from their e-filing account at <https://www.incometax.gov.in/iec/foportal>
